Miami Norland Senior Homecoming Dance Dress Code

Girls will wear semi formal attire or formal gowns or pantsuits. Strapless and spaghetti straps will be permitted.

Reminders:

Dresses are to be no shorter than fingertip length, (front and back). This also applies to slits in dresses. Dress must also be at the appropriate length even if leggings are worn underneath the dress.

Dress may not be extremely low-cut in the front or back. The front of the dress must not fall below the bra line; the back of the dress must not fall below the waist.

Dresses may not be extremely tight or form-fitting. Be aware of the material that gathers and rises when you walk.

Shorts are allowed but they must follow the fingertip rule.

The following will not be permitted:

Two-piece formal gowns or pants and top, where the midriff is showing

Dresses with revealing cut-outs

See-though gowns (this includes sheer/mesh overlays that do not have material underneath) Torn clothing

Caps

Boys are encouraged to wear a suit or sports coat, but at a minimum, they are expected to wear semi-formal wear, such as slacks, nice shoes, and a nice shirt. Torn clothing will <u>not</u> be permitted. Ties are encouraged, but not required.

<u>All students</u>:

If the attire is questionable, students are encouraged to show their evening wear to administrators beforehand to determine if it is dance appropriate.

The determination of the appropriateness of student dress and grooming shall rest with the principal and assistant principals.

Students and their dates who are non-compliant with the dress code will not be admitted to the dance or will be escorted out of the dance. No refunds will be given for dance dress code infractions in which these students are asked to leave.

Back of the dress must not fall below the waist



(Dress is APPROPRIATE)



The front of the dress must <u>not</u> fall below the bra line (Dress is INAPPROPRIATE because it is cut too low)



(Dress is APPROPRIATE because it falls at the bra line)

This dress is appropriate Dress must not be shorter than fingertip length Dress must also be at the appropriate length even if leggings are worn underneath the dress.

Suggestive Dancing and Public Displays of Affection

Styles of dancing that the administration /chaperones determine to be inappropriate for a school dance setting will not be permitted. The style of dancing referred to includes dancing in a manner that strongly suggests sexual activity.

Public displays of affection will not be acceptable. The behavior referred to includes kissing or other displays of intimacy inappropriate for a school dance setting.

Consequences:

Students will not be permitted into the dance or will be escorted out of the dance. No money will be refunded

Homecoming Dance Guest

A MNSH student may bring one outside guest no older than the age of 20 to the dance. Middle school and junior high school students will not be admitted.. The application must be submitted for approval before the Friday prior to the dance being held. Students and their guests will be checked in at the dance. Picture ID cards of all participants will be checked at the door.
